The **2009 Hamilton Fellows Program** is designed to attract outstanding individuals from a variety of academic disciplines to the Department of the Treasury's Departmental Offices (Treasury headquarters). Hamilton Fellows have a unique opportunity to witness and contribute to Treasury's important mission: *"managing the U.S. Government's finances effectively, promoting economic growth and stability, and ensuring the safety, soundness, and security of the U.S. international financial systems."*

Treasury invites individuals completing a graduate degree by June 2009 from to apply to the Hamilton Fellows Program. All positions will be located in Washington DC. Participants in the two-year program will receive both formal and on-the-job training, and be mentored by a Treasury employee. Fellows may be assigned to work in any of the offices in Treasury headquarters, depending on the candidates' interests and skills and the needs of the organization. Key occupational areas for assignment may include financial management, financial and economic analysis (domestic and international), information technology, human resources, and acquisition. We are looking for highly-motivated individuals with strong research, analytic and writing skills, who can work both independently and collaboratively. Those selected for the program will begin in July 2009. (U.S. Citizenship and basic security check are required.)

The starting salary is \$50,408 (GS-9) with the opportunity for promotions up to approximately \$70,000 (GS-12) based on performance. In addition to salary, Treasury offers a comprehensive benefits package. Treasury offices are conveniently located in downtown DC - within walking distance of multiple metro stations, restaurants and shops, museums, and theaters. Participants may be eligible for a permanent position after successful completion of the two year program.

Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis with a deadline of March 20 for first consideration, April 3 for second consideration, and April 17 for third consideration.
