

**Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR)  
FY 2010 Quarter 2**

Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) was offered to 94% of completed counselings in FY 2010 Quarter 2. In Quarter 2, Treasury exceeded its goal of 35% ADR participation in the informal process with a 53% participation rate.

In the formal process, Treasury did not meet its ADR offer goals. Only 55% of closed cases in Quarter 2 were offered ADR. Of those cases offered ADR, 55% participated in ADR.

The Treasury Shared Neutrals (TSN) Program maintains a nationwide cadre of highly trained certified neutrals (also known as mediators). The TSN mediators assist bureaus in resolving all types of workplace disputes at the earliest stages of conflict management through mediation, facilitation, and coaching. In Quarter 2 FY 2010, TSN received 8 requests for mediators to assist in resolving disputes.
