

Real property in the County of Penobscot, State of Maine, described as follows:

The Bragg Lot, so-called, in LaGrange, Maine, Being the premises described in a deed dated January 15, 1941 recorded in the Penobscot County Registry of Deeds in Vol. 1157, Page 449.

The description of said real estate in the deed recorded in Vol. 1157, Page 449 is: "A certain lot or parcel of land situated in LaGrange in said County of Penobscot described as follows, to wit: Being Lot numbered ninety-five (95) according to the plan and survey of Isaac Libby made in 1869, and being the same land conveyed to Ishabod Cary, Jr., by C.W. Coffin by deed dated April 12, 1880, and recorded in the Penobscot County Registry of Deeds in Vol. 811, Page 100. Also another lot or parcel of land situated in said LaGrange, according to the plan and survey of Isaac Libby made in 1869, viz: Being lot numbered ninety-six (96) on the East side of the Bennoch Road. Both the above described parcels being the same conveyed by Estolle L. Andrews and another to Nellie Whidden by deed dated October 31, 1912 recorded in the Penobscot County Registry of Deeds in Vol. 843, Page 272."
