Linda has moved to the Wage and Investment Division of the IRS leading teams and supporting their efforts.

Linda's motivation for supporting the Veterans Employment Program Office is due to her two sons: Jerry who served in the US Marines for four years and SSG Ernesto Ortiz, who is currently serving in the U.S. Army for twelve years. Linda is certainly a proud mother of the military.
