Executive Order 13722 of March 15, 2016
**Blocking Property of the Government of North Korea and the Workers' Party of Korea,
and Prohibiting Certain Transactions with Respect to North Korea**

GENERAL LICENSE NO. 2

Provision of Certain Legal Services Authorized

(a) The provision of the following legal services to or on behalf of the Government of North Korea, the Workers' Party of Korea, or any other person whose property and interests in property are blocked pursuant to Executive Order 13687 of January 2, 2015, Executive Order 13551 of August 30, 2010, or Executive Order 13722 of March 15, 2016 or any further Executive orders relating to the national emergency declared in Executive Order 13466 of June 26, 2008, or to or on behalf of a person in North Korea, or in circumstances in which the benefit is otherwise received in North Korea, is authorized, provided that receipt of payment of professional fees and reimbursement of incurred expenses are authorized by or pursuant to paragraph (d) of this section, or otherwise licensed:

(1) Provision of legal advice and counseling on the requirements of and compliance with the laws of the United States or any jurisdiction within the United States, provided that such advice and counseling are not provided to facilitate transactions in violation of this part;

(2) Representation of persons named as defendants in or otherwise made parties to legal, arbitration, or administrative proceedings before any U.S. federal, state, or local court or agency;

(3) Initiation and conduct of legal, arbitration, or administrative proceedings before any U.S. federal, state, or local court or agency;

(4) Representation of persons before any U.S. federal, state, or local court or agency with respect to the imposition, administration, or enforcement of U.S. sanctions against such persons or North Korea; and

(5) Provision of legal services in any other context in which prevailing U.S. law requires access to legal counsel at public expense.

(b) The provision of any other legal services to the Government of North Korea, the Workers' Party of Korea, or any other person whose property and interests in property are blocked pursuant to Executive Order 13551 of August 20, 2010, Executive Order 13687 of January 2, 2015, Executive Order 13722 of March 15, 2016, or any further Executive orders relating to the national emergency declared in Executive Order 13466 of June 26, 2008, or to or on behalf of a person in North Korea, or in circumstances in which the benefit is otherwise received in North Korea, not otherwise authorized in this part, requires the issuance of a specific license.

(c) Entry into a settlement agreement or the enforcement of any lien, judgment, arbitral award, decree, or other order through execution, garnishment, or other judicial process purporting to transfer or otherwise alter or affect property or interests in property blocked pursuant to Executive Order 13687 of January 2, 2015, Executive Order 13722 of March 15, 2016 or any further Executive orders relating to the national emergency declared in Executive Order 13466 of June 26, 2008 is prohibited unless licensed.

(d) *Receipt of payment.* (1) *Legal services to or on behalf of blocked persons.* All receipt of payment of professional fees and reimbursement of incurred expenses for the provision of legal services authorized pursuant to paragraph (a) of this section to or on behalf of the Government of North Korea, the Workers' Party of Korea, or any other person whose property and interests in property are blocked pursuant to Executive Order 13687 of January 2, 2015, Executive Order 13551 of August 30, 2010, Executive Order 13722 of March 15, 2016, or any further Executive orders relating to the national emergency declared in Executive Order 13466 of June 26, 2008 must be specifically licensed.

(2) *Legal services to or on behalf of all others.* All receipt of payment of professional fees and reimbursement of incurred expenses for the provision of legal services authorized pursuant to paragraph (a) of this section to or on behalf of a person in North Korea, or in circumstances in which the benefit is otherwise received in North Korea, other than those described in paragraph (d)(1) of this section, are authorized, except that nothing in this section authorizes the debiting of any blocked account or the transfer of any blocked property.
