Executive Order 13722 of March 15, 2016  
**Blocking Property of the Government of North Korea and the Workers' Party of Korea,  
and Prohibiting Certain Transactions with Respect to North Korea**

GENERAL LICENSE NO. 7

**Transactions Related to Telecommunications and Mail Authorized**

(a)(1) Except as provided in paragraph (a)(2) of this general license, all transactions necessary to the receipt and transmission of telecommunications involving North Korea are authorized.

(2) This general license does not authorize:

(i) The provision, sale, or lease of telecommunications equipment or technology; or

(ii) The provision, sale, or lease of capacity on telecommunications transmission facilities (such as satellite or terrestrial network activity).

(b) All transactions of common carriers incident to the receipt or transmission of mail and packages between the United States and North Korea are authorized provided that the importation or exportation of such mail and packages is exempt from or authorized pursuant to 31 CFR part 510, Executive Order 13570 of April 18, 2011, Executive Order 13551 of August 30, 2010, Executive Order 13466 of June 26, 2008, or Executive Order 13722 of March 15, 2016.

**Note to General License 7:** This general license does not authorize funds transfers involving financial institutions that are blocked pursuant to any part of 31 CFR chapter V other than part 510.
